KMPS Book day & Parade

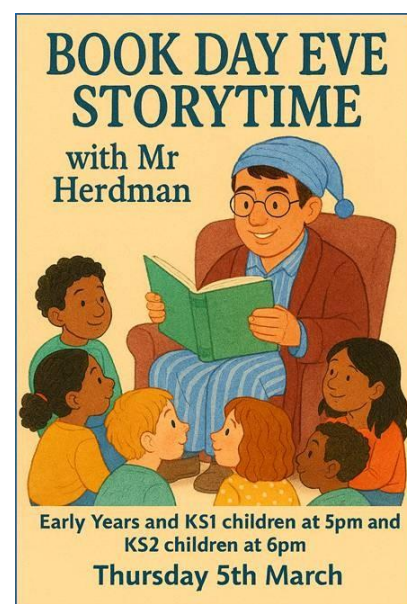
We are excited to celebrate KMPS Book Day on **Friday 6th March**.
